<u>ALL YEAR</u>

□ Individual 10 year plan meeting and graduation requirement review with your counselor

- □ Complete community service hours and submit at: <u>x2vol.com</u>
- $\hfill\square$ Check your grades routinely on Infinite Campus and study hard

□ Continue Career exploration by listening to professional speakers, exploring resources and tools in family connection/ naviance, field trips to local businesses, job shadowing, community service, etc.

FALL (September-November)

- □ Log in to Family Connection <u>http://connection.naviance.com/wickliffehs</u>
 - Username: 6 digit student id (found on your schedule)
 - Password: your birthdate yyyymmdd (i.e. if your birthday is May 1, 1999, your password would be: 19990501)

□ Continue adding clusters to your favorites in family connection. You can complete the cluster finder again to identify additional interests

WINTER (December-February)

- December: Prepare for semester exams
- Begin researching prospective college and career requirements, education and training
- Attend Educational Options Night (College Credit Plus) if interested college credit

SPRING (March-May)

- Take the PSAT 9
- Prepare for semester Exams
