ALL YEAR

- Individual 10 year plan meeting and graduation requirement review with your counselor
- Complete 2 college visit days or 2 job shadow days (or 1 of each)
- Complete community service hours and submit at: x2vol.com (login instructions on reverse)
- Check your grades routinely on Infinite Campus and study hard
- Continue exploring career opportunities and research levels of education & training required
- Stay in contact with your counselor throughout the school year to review graduation requirements and pathways, college/career development, etc.
- Athletes considering Division I or Division II sports, visit NCAA student-athlete information at <https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/>
- Research and apply for scholarships in the Scholarship List in Family Connection on Colleges tab

FALL (September-November)

- Research college admission requirements for prospective colleges
- Register to take the ACT (actstudent.org) and/or the SAT (sat.org)
- Complete "College Super Match" in Family Connection
- Complete "Colleges I'm Applying to" in Family Connection
- Attend Financial Aid Night with a parent on Monday, October 2 at 6:30 p.m at WHS
- Make an appointment with the LEAF advisor
- File for the FAFSA for student aid at www.fafsa.gov after October 1
- Use Naviance/ family connection to request transcripts, complete applications, link your common app account, and teacher recommendations
- Complete college applications and/or finalize post high school plans
- Be aware of ALL deadlines (scholarships, college applications, FAFSA deadlines, high school requirements, etc.)

WINTER (December-February)

- Continue researching and applying for scholarships
- Be on the lookout for Senior Project details - TBA

SPRING (March-May)

- Complete Graduation Survey in Naviance
- Attend Senior Award Night (by invitation)
- Prepare for AP Exams and Final Exams
- Attend Commencement upon completion of all graduation requirements
