ALL YEAR

- Individual 10 year plan meeting and graduation requirement review with your counselor
- Complete 2 college visit days or 2 job shadow days (or 1 of each)
- Complete community service hours and submit at: x2vol.com (**see reverse for log in info**)
- Check your grades routinely on Infinite Campus and study hard
- Continue Career exploration by listening to professional speakers, exploring resources and tools in family connection/ naviance, field trips to local businesses, job shadowing, community service, attending career technical presentations and field trips, etc.
- Athletes considering Division I or Division II sports, visit NCAA student-athlete information at <https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/>

FALL (September-November)

- Optional for college bound students: Register for the PSAT/NMSQT
- Log in to Family Connection <http://connection.naviance.com/wickliffehs>
Username: 6 digit student id (found on your schedule)
Password: your birthdate yyyymmdd (i.e. if your birthday is May 1, 1999, your password would be: 19990501)
- Explore the different tabs in Family Connection: College, Career, About Me and My Planner. Complete the "Career Interest Profiler"

WINTER (December-February)

- Prepare for semester exams
- Research requirements for prospective college/ career interests
- Complete "StrengthsExplorer" in Family Connection
- Take practice tests for the ACT/SAT/ASVAB/ACCUPLACER, etc.
- Attend Educational Options Night (College Credit Plus) if interested college credit
- Request a strong junior schedule that aligns with plans after high school

SPRING (March-May)

- Complete "College Super Match" in Family Connection
- Optional: Complete "Colleges I'm thinking About" in Family Connection
- Prepare for AP Exams if applicable
- Testing Day (TBA): All sophomores will be taking the PreACT
- Prepare for semester Exams

SUMMER (June-August)

- Get a summer job and expand experiences
- Narrow down college and/or career choices
