Crossroads Health

Crossroads Health offers a continuum of recovery and mental health programs and services for all people, at any age or stage of life. As a community-based nonprofit, Crossroads Health is committed to providing trauma-informed, evidence-based services that change lives and impact communities. Signature Health Inc.

Signature Health Inc. currently offers mental health counseling and primary care services at the WFRC. The Signature Health team treats both the mind and body, with an integrated approach to health care for all ages. Medicaid and Medicare insurance is accepted, and they offer a sliding fee scale for those without insurance. Wickloset

Wickloset is a student-led organization dedicated to providing local families with free, easy access to non-perishable food items, clothing, toiletries, and more. For questions about receiving assistance or donating to Wickloset, call the Wickliffe Family Resource Center at (440) 943-6113.



Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)

WIC is a supplemental nutrition program. WIC provides education and nutritious foods that promote good health for pregnant women, women who just had a baby, breastfeeding moms, infants, and children up to age five. Community Impact

- **American Red Cross Blood Drives**
 - 175 pints of blood collected since October 2020
- **Free Mobile Dental Clinics**
 - 247 dental appointments since May 2021
- **Free Sports Physicals through Signature Health**
 - 89 sports physicals since July 2021
- **VITA Program through Lifeline**
 - Free tax preparation to 130 clients since February 2021
- **WickCloset - Food, Clothing, and Toiletries**
 - Approximately 250 families served this year
- **Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)**
 - Approximately 250 families served per month
- **Signature Health School-Based Counseling**
 - Approximately 70 established clients
- **Annual Back-to-School Bash - 2022 Stats**
 - 150 students received school supplies
 - 62 students received back-to-school haircuts
 - 63 families received toiletries
 - 57 families received food packages
- **Distribution Site for COVID-19 At-Home Tests**
- **Free Supply Station at Wickliffe High School**
 - Located in the main hallway of WHS
 - Stocked with school supplies and items such as deodorant, toothbrushes, body wash, etc. for students
- **Distribution Site for N95 Masks**
 - Approximately 250 families served this year
- **"Free Little Food Pantry"**
 - One pantry outside of the WFRC, and one outside of the Wickliffe Senior Center
 - For food needs outside of business hours
 - Public encouraged to "take what you need, and leave what you can"
- **"Free Little Library"**
 - Provide 2 bookshelves in WFRC—one for kids, one for adults
 - Patrons encouraged to donate/take books
- **Annual Thanksgiving Distribution - 2022 Stats**
 - 60+ families received food packages including non-perishables, fresh dairy and produces, and a turkey/turkey breast
