Lab Safety Rules & Procedures Mr. Genovese - 6th Grade Science

In order to safely participate in laboratory investigations, appropriate behavior is required. Students who violate the rules and procedures will be removed from the lab and given an alternate assignment.

- 6. Use the lab equipment as intended and instructed.
- 7. Stay out of storage areas unless instructed by teacher.
- 8. Report any breakage of equipment immediately to the teacher.

Failure to follow the rules and procedures outlined in the safety plan may revoke privileges to participate in lab investigations. Alternate assignments will be given to those who violate the rules, procedures, and lab instructions.
