PK-12 Facility Update

- Architect, construction manager, engineers, and commissioning agent have all be selected
- Bonds sold
- Schematic design will be complete in June
- The cost estimation process will be complete by the end of July
- Design presentation to the community in August
- Staff meetings resume in September regarding interior design
- Final cost estimate and design work completed by end of December 2020
- Final design presentation in January 2021

PK-12 Facility Update

- Community Input Process (through 5/27/20)
 - Staff input meetings- Internal Space
 - Student surveys- Lockers and Space Needs
 - Exterior design survey- over 300 participants
 - Educational visioning session
 - Facility committee meetings prior to Bond Issue
 - Eco-Charrette Process- Representatives from the City of Wickliffe, Lake County Metro Parks, Residents
 - Site visits were conducted
