Team 7 Classroom Procedures

Detentions

In the event of a disruption, the following consequences apply:

1. Warning(s) from teacher
2. Team 7 Lunch Detention – (recorded by team, parent not notified)
3. Repeat Offenses (recorded by team and parent notified via email or phone call)
4. Continuous Issues will be referred to the office for consequences appropriate to situation

Team 7 Lunch Detentions can be given for any of the following reasons: disrespect to teacher, disruptive behavior, late to class, chewing gum, lack of materials, and behavior for substitute teacher

Hall Passes:

Passes to the office or nurse are given for emergencies only as determined by the teacher.

Assignment Notebooks:

Students are expected to use their assignment notebooks daily. Periodically, team teachers will review the appropriate use of the notebooks. An organization grade will be given within the language arts classes. The language arts teachers will define these requirements for the students in class.

Homework Policy:

Homework is expected to be completed and handed in on time for the opportunity to receive full credit.

A student may receive ½ credit if the assignment is received by 3:00 pm on the day it is due.

Any missing assignments may be handed in to receive a completion grade.

If a student misses assignments due to illness, he or she will be given the number of days absent to make up the work for full credit.

Quarterly Reward:

Throughout the year, Team 7 likes to reward ***completed work***, a ***sincere effort***, and ***good behavior*** with a reward each quarter. There are requirements the students must fulfill in order to earn the reward:

- 1. No more than 1 zero in each core subject (LA, Math, Science, or Social Studies); a second zero will eliminate you from a reward.**
- 2. The quality of work must be acceptable to each core teacher (relative to the student's academic ability).**
- 3. No more than 1 detention in each core subject (LA, Math, Science, or Social Studies); a second detention will eliminate you from a reward. Skipping a team detention will also eliminate you from a reward.**
- 4. No school suspensions.**
