



Yearly Notice of Parents Right-to-Know Title I Schoolwide Requirement

Every Student Succeeds Act (Public Law 114-95, Section 1112(e)(1)(A)

Dear WES Families:

You have the right to know about the teaching qualifications of your child's classroom teacher in a school receiving Title I funds. The federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that any school district receiving Title I fund must notify parents of each student attending any school receiving Title I funds that they may request, and the district will provide the parents on request (and in a timely manner), information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers, including at a minimum, the following:

1. Whether the teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction. <u>All teachers in the elementary</u> building are Highly Qualified and possess the criteria for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.

2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived. If your child has a teacher that is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived for some reason, the district will notify all families of students in that classroom.

3. Whether the teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of that teacher. <u>All</u> elementary teachers are teaching within the field of discipline of their state certification.

4. Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications. <u>All educational aides at the elementary school are properly credentialed</u> and licensed by the state of Ohio and they work in classrooms with children, but are working under the direct supervision of the classroom teacher at all times.
