Some of the sustainable features incorporated as LEED Silver Certification is pursued are listed below:

- No CFC's in HVAC equipment (reduces ozone)
- Use of building materials that are regionally procured and of recycled content.
- Individual control of HVAC on all interior spaces.
- Increased water efficiency through the use of low-flow plumbing fixtures.
- No landscape irrigation and use of native plant species to save water.
- Increased building energy efficiency, 30% or more, from a standard building.
- Diversion of 50% to 75% of construction waste from landfills.
- Use of low VOC materials (paints, adhesives, carpets, casework)
- Incorporation of daylighting for increased natural light and energy savings.
- Using "green" or "sustainable" features as a teaching tool in curriculum.
